

Recital Information 2024: <u>Ballet Recital</u> A Midsummer Night's Dream

Location: Margaret W. Rudder Theater at Rudder High School Rehearsal: Friday, May 17th at 4:45 PM, Call time is 4:30 PM Performance: Friday, May 17th at 7:00 PM, Doors Open at 6:45 PM

IMPORTANT NOTE: All ballet costumes are provided for by the studio and will be at the theater upon your dancers arrival.

Checklist for dancers:

- clean, hole free, skin toned tights
- appropriate undergarments
- Secure ballet hairstyle off face and neck. Smooth hair in secure ballet bun, Textured hair secured off of face and neck
- □ stage make up complete
- □ appropriate dance shoes & tights:
 - Ballet Shoes- skin toned canvas, split sole ballet shoes
 - □ skin toned microfiber convertible, seamless tights
- U We recommend that dancers ballet III and up have a stage kit with the following items for back up:
 - stage makeup
 - □ hair accessories: brush, hair ties, bobby pins, hair nets, hairspray
 - extra pair of tights

In order to ensure a smooth and enjoyable performance for everyone, please discuss these important rules with your dancer.

- 1. Always listen to teachers and volunteers. Stay focused and follow directions
- 2. No running or horseplay will be permitted.
- 3. Join your class in your assigned area.
- 4. Be responsible for your personal belongings and clean up after yourself.
- 5. No street shoes on stage.
- 6. Quiet voices while waiting.
- 7. If you have quick changes, all costumes must be set at least 15 minutes to showtime.
- 8. DO NOT MOVE costumes or props that are not yours.
- 9. Dancers are to remain in their areas until their line up for their dance/check out at the end of the show.
- 10. Only closeable water bottles will be allowed backstage. No snacks allowed.

CARE OF COSTUME

- Label everything! Write your dancer's name in every single item, hair piece, tights and shoe.
- NEVER EAT ANYTHING WHILE IN YOUR COSTUME.
- wait for assistance from the costume team for your costume
- No sitting, or eating once in costume.
- return costume to costume team. do not leave on floor, hanging over a chair, in bathroom, on counter etc.
- Place all accessories for each costume in a Ziploc bag. Write your dancer's name and the name of the routine on the outside of the bag with a permanent marker.

PERFORMER APPEARANCE

- Hair should be in a secure ballet hair style and completely off face. It should be sprayed heavily with hairspray or gelled to minimize flyaways and keep it in place.
- Stage makeup is required. Stage lights wash out beautiful little faces without makeup.
- NO colored clips, ribbons, or hair ties unless it's a costume piece.
- Remove all jewelry and nail polish.
- Tights must be new with no holes or runs. Each dancer should bring an extra pair of tights for each costume.
- Appropriate flesh toned undergarments under tights or costumes only.
- All shoes should be cleaned or new.

ARRIVING AT PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

- Dancers should arrive ready for warm up class, in their ballet class attire and warm ups with hair and make-up done and all other items in their dance bag.
- Dancers will be signed in at the checkpoint. Volunteers and dancers are the only ones allowed backstage.
- Dancers must remain backstage with their class for the duration of the recital.
- All dancers will have an assigned waiting area with supervision.

AUDIENCE INFORMATION

NOTE: NO PHOTOGRAPHY OR RECORDING OF ANY KIND IS ALLOWED during the performance. A digital

download of the performance will be provided for all families participating in the recital at no additional

charge. Photo opportunities in the lobby will be available after the show.

- Once checking in your dancers, parents may leave until it's time for the theater to open for audience seating.
- please stay seated for the entire show
- Flowers and gifts will be available for purchase before the show and during intermission, but pre-ordering is strongly recommended.

PICKING UP YOUR DANCER

- Dancers will be signed out at the checkpoint immediately following the performance.
- No dancer will be released prior to that time.
- No dancer under age 12 will be released to anyone except a parent, unless we have written permission prior to the performance.
- All dancers MUST remain with their class for the entire show.
